2.1 Installation Method

1) Turn the power supply OFF. Remove the top cover (A in the figure on the right) and peripheral equipment connector cover (B in the figure on the right) from the front of the main unit.



2) Attach the provided side cover (C in the figure on the right).

For the 40/60-point types, it is not necessary to attach the side cover.

3) Connect the connector conversion adapter to the optional equipment connector (D in the figure on the right), and fix it using the provided M3 tapping screws (E in the figure on the right).


